PNKF IAIDO SEMINAR, JUNE 29 AND 30, 1996

The second Iaido Seminar for 1996 continued the high intensity and excitement of the February 29 one. Teachers were Murosako Sensei and Konno Sensei, supported by Anderson Sensei, Bolling Sensei and Stroud Sensei.

First there was an in-depth review of the ZenKenRen Iai. (NOTE: the Zen Nippon Kendo Renmei "Seitei" Iai curriculum is now known simply as the "ZenKenRen" Iai curriculum, to distinguish it from the Zen Nippon Iaido Renmei Seitei set.)

After the ZenKenRen review, we then launched into the Muso Shinden Ryu Shoden, Omori Ryu. All the basics of the Omori Ryu were fully covered.

The first day ended with a leisurely and delicious feast at Casa Lupita, during which Murosako Sensei and Konno Sensei continued to teach and answer questions about many aspects and dimensions of Iai and Kendo.

The second day, there was a general review of the Omori Ryu, and continued in-depth training in smaller groups for both Omori Ryu and ZenKenRen. Finally, there was a clear explanation of how Iaido Shiai matches are held, ending up with an actual "dry-run" Shiai, with all participants taking part.

The Seminar was also an opportunity for participants to obtain or order excellent quality training equipment such as Iaito, Obi, and Gi. Each person also received very detailed handouts giving the Kanji, Romaji, and English for essential Iaido terminology.

We eagerly await the next PNKF Iaido Seminar with more opportunities to learn about this basic foundation of our Kendo training and study.
